

A Clutch puller is useful in removing the clutch from the main axle in those cases where it really sticks.

They are easy to make with help of given thread dimension.



Thread on puller $\text{\O} 1 \frac{1}{4}$ inch (31, mm) 20 TPI

Spannersize 32 mm but any convenient size over 32 mm can obviously be used

Centre bolt M10 used, also a free choice but should be big enough but not exceeding the main axle diameter.

The original looks like this.



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
